Dear Mr. Mayor, Members of Council & City Staff,

The Downtown Port Colborne BIA held their monthly board meeting this past Tuesday May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022. At our meeting we received a request for support from the owners of Canalside Pub & Eatery as they are having an issue with the language of the revised Patio Policy which is preventing them from receiving their Patio Renewal for this year.

We understand that their geography is a unique layout and would require special provisions based on them not having the traditional parking stalls in front of their business.

As a board we have discussed their situation and wish to offer our unanimous support and request that they be granted space on the grass area across from their establishment as they have been for the past two seasons. We understand that a compromise of 2 angle parking spaces was suggested however we strongly discourage this plan as the block in which they are located continues to be a hot spot for parking issues and the removal of two spots in the block would increase what is already a high traffic, problemed area.
