Being a by-law to adopt, ratify and confirm the proceedings of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne at its Special Closed Meeting of April 23, 2024		
Whereas Section 5(1) of the <i>Municipal Act, 2001,</i> provides that the powers of a municipality shall be exercised by its council; and		
Whereas Section 5(3) of the <i>Municipal Act, 2001,</i> provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise; and		
Whereas it is deemed expedient that the proceedings of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne be confirmed and adopted by by-law;		
Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacts as follows:		
1.	Every action of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Port Colborne taken at its Special Closed Meeting of April 23, 2024, upon which a vote was taken and passed whether a resolution, recommendations, adoption by reference, or other means, is hereby enacted as a by-law of the City to take effect upon the passing hereof.	
2.	That the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute any documents required on behalf of the City and affix the corporate seal of the City and the Mayor and Clerk, and such other persons as the action directs, are authorized and directed to take the necessary steps to implement the action.	
3.	That the Clerk is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections, or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical, or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this bylaw.
