5. Stop Gap Presentation

O. Loeffen presented on the StopGap program to the committee.

6. Staff Update

- S. McDougall and G.R. Bisson were introduced to the committee.
- S. McDougall is the lead on the Community Curators project through the Port Colborne Historical and Marine Museum. The Seniors Advisory Committee will be participating in this project in celebration of the Museum's 50th anniversary.
- G. R. Bisson is the Senior Community Engagement Advisor at the City of Port Colborne and will be working closely with committees under council.

7. Order of Business

7.1 Seniors Expo Update

- S. Brown shared the vendor list for the expo. 24 vendors have agreed to participate in the event. S. Brown will be sending out emails to all vendors with information about the event and the schedule for the day. S. Brown also shared the 5 sponsors for the event and what they are providing.
- S. Brown will send out an email to all committee members with a schedule for the day of the event and where all members are stationed.
- S. McDowell will inventory the committees magnifier cards and pamphlets and source more if needed.
- S. McDowell will handle the pick up of any sponsored food and drinks on the day of the event.
- S. McDowell reported that the Port Colborne Historical and Marine Museum will be providing a door prize for the event.

The committee discussed transportation for the event and the viability of hiring a shuttle bus for the day. O. Loeffen updated the committee on available bus companies and the price of each for the day.

a. Flag Raising

b. Ontario's Senior of the Year Award

S. McDowell reported that the City has nominated a local senior to receive the Ontario Senior of the Year award.

The Ontario Senior of the Year award is presented by municipalities across the province to recognize exceptional seniors who, after the age of 65, continue to enrich the social, cultural or civic fabric of their community.

There will be a small ceremony held to celebrate the recipient of the award.

c. Social Media Campaign

The Communications Department will be overseeing a social media campaign throughout seniors month to highlight the Seniors Advisory Committee and promote an age-friendly community in Port Colborne.

The posts will be weekly and feature events happening throughout the month including the flag raising, senior of the year award, and seniors expo.

8. New Business

8.1 Essential Needs Program

T. McDowell reported that Connecting Care Niagara recently introduced the 'essential needs program' that provides seniors with essential products they may not otherwise be able to afford including things like shampoo, soap, toothpaste and other products.

This may be something the committee can assist in promoting, as many seniors living independently may not have heard about it.

T. McDowell will send information on the program and how to apply to committee members.
