# COST



If done by City Staff  
- it will save money



Paint is inexpensive

Most expensive option is not  
desirable, as there is the  
potential for road construction

## Paint

- ~\$100 – \$200 / gallon
- Each Cross Walk needs 6 gallons, totaling 24 gallons of road paint
- ~\$2,400 – \$4,800 for all four cross walks
